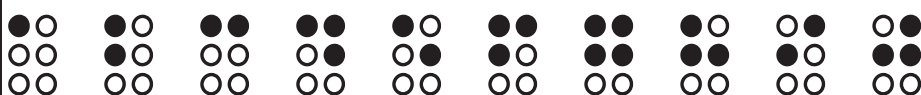


# The Braille Code

a b c d e f g h i j



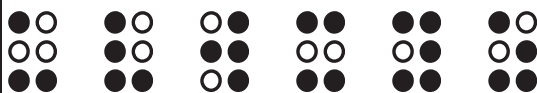
The first ten letters of the alphabet use the dots in the first two rows of the Braille Cell.

k l m n o p q r s t



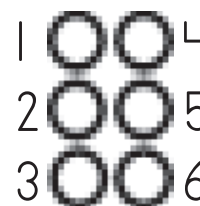
Letters k-t add a dot 3 to the first ten letters.

u v w x y z



The last letters add a dot 3 and 6 to the first five letters. The exception is W, which was added later.

## The Braille Cell



The Braille cell is made up of 6 dots.

exclamation mark !

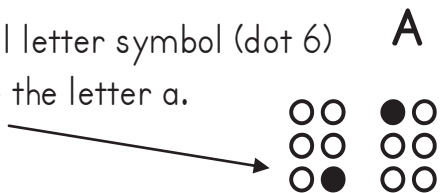
comma ,

question mark ?

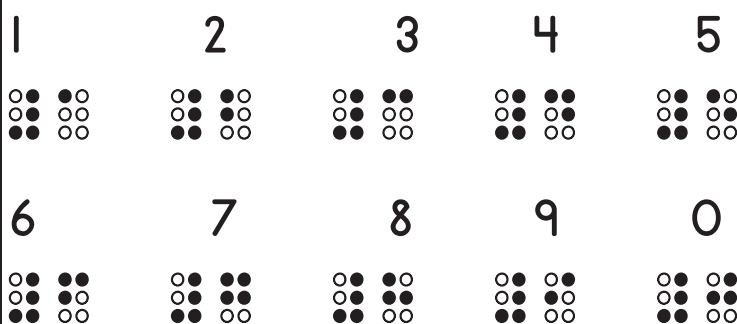
## Capital Letters

The capital sign (dot 6) placed before a letter makes a capital letter.

Capital letter symbol (dot 6) before the letter a.



## Braille Numbers



Numbers are made by placing the number sign before the letters a-j.
